## I. INTERNATIONAL TOURISM > EZEIZA AND JORGE NEWBERY

INTERNATIONAL TOURIST ARRIVALS IN BUENOS AIRES AND INTERANNUAL VARIATION (BY %) BY MONTH. DECEMBER 2017 - DECEMBER 2018.





- International tourist arrivals by air grew by 11.8% in December 2018 (the largest increase in the year). The 216,576 arrivals is the highest number for any month since January 2012.

The growth was led by Brazil (+26.6%) followed by Chile (+23.1%), Rest of America (+11.7%), the USA and Canada (+9.6%) and Rest of the World (7%).



- Between January and December 2018 2 million tourists arrived in Buenos Aires by air (+5.1%), 98,300 more visitors than in 2017.
- The markets leading the growth over 2018 were Brazil (28,400 more visitors, +5.3%) Rest of the World (+21,800, or +14.8% YoY, Chile (+19,000 more tourists, or +10,4% YoY), Europe (+17,000 or +4.6%), and USA (+7,600 visitors, or +3.3%).
- Overnight stays totalled 20.1 million (+14.4%, or 2.5 million more nights.)



### II. NATIONAL TOURISM IN HOTELS

#### ARGENTINE TOURIST HOTEL STAYS. DECEMBER 2017 - DECEMBER 2018





- In December, 181,415 Argentine tourists stayed in hotels in Buenos Aires (-14.2% YoY).
- Over all 2018, 2,5 million Argentine tourists stayed in hotels in the city, 8.6% less than in 2017.
- The occupancy rate for hotel rooms in December was 57%, (-1.1 percentage points against December 2017). The average occupancy rate for the year was 59.4% (+0.3% compared with 2017)
