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I. INTERNATIONAL TOURISM > EZEIZA AND JORGE NEWBERY

INTERNATIONAL TOURIST ARRIVALS IN BUENOS AIRES AND INTERANNUAL VARIATION (BY %) BY MONTH. FEBRUARY 2018 - FEBRUARY 2019.





- International tourist arrivals by air grew by 15.5% in February 2019, the third consecutive month with an increase above 10%. The 159,046 arrivals made it the February with the highest number of arrivals since 2012.

The growth was led by Chile (+43.5%), followed by Rest of America (+23.6%), Europe (+12.5%), and Brazil (+11%).



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- In the first two months of the year, 391,000 tourists (+19.9%) arrived in Buenos Aires by air, 60,000 more visitors than in the same period in 2018.
- The markets leading the growth over 2018 were Brazil (+30% or +22,000 more visitors) Europe (+18% or +15,000), Rest of America (+20.1% or +13,000), and Chile (+54.5% or +9,000).
- Total overnight stays during January and February 2018 reached 4.8 million (+12.8%, or 544,000 more nights than in the first two months of 2018.)






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II. NATIONAL TOURISM IN HOTELS

ARGENTINE TOURIST HOTEL STAYS. FEB 2018 - FEB 2019





- In January, 166,838 Argentine tourists stayed in hotels in Buenos Aires (-11.6% YoY). They stayed a total of 361,000 nights, down 11.9% against 2018.
- The occupancy rate for hotel rooms was 55.5%, down 0.5 percentage points against the same period in 2018.
