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I. INTERNATIONAL TOURISM > EZEIZA AND JORGE NEWBERY

INTERNATIONAL TOURIST ARRIVALS IN BUENOS AIRES AND INTERANNUAL VARIATION (BY %) BY MONTH. APRIL 2018 – APRIL 2019.





- In April 2019, 179,253 international tourists arrived in Buenos Aires by air (+13% YOY), led by Brazil (+35.5% YoY), Chile (+23.4%) and Europe (+9%).
- International visitors made 1,5 million overnight stays, up +9,8% YOY owing to the performance of the above markets.



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- In the first four months of 2019, 760,000 tourists (+17.1% YoY) arrived in Buenos Aires by air, 111,000 more visitors than in the same period in 2018.
- The increase was led by the outbound markets of Brazil (+39.2%), Chile (+25.9%) Europe (+15.8%) and the Rest of the Americas (+13.8%).
- Total overnight stays in January through April reached 6.8 million (+14%, or 1.5 million more nights than in the same period in 2018.)

INTERNATIONAL TOURIST ARRIVALS IN BUENOS AIRES, BY REGION. JAN-APR 2014 to JAN-APR 2019






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II. NATIONAL TOURISM IN HOTELS

ARGENTINE TOURIST HOTEL STAYS. APR 2018 – APR 2019





- In April 2019, 197,000 Argentine tourists stayed in hotels in Buenos Aires (-14.8% YOY).
- The occupancy rate for hotel rooms was 58%, down 0.2 percentage points against the same period in 2018. The difference was compensated for by the increase in international tourists staying in hotels (+4% YOY).
- -The accumulated occupancy rate (January to April) was 56.5% (-1.6 p.p.) on 2018.
