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I. INTERNATIONAL TOURISM > EZEIZA AND JORGE NEWBERY

INTERNATIONAL TOURIST ARRIVALS IN BUENOS AIRES AND INTERANNUAL VARIATION (BY %) BY MONTH. JULY 2018 – JULY 2019.





- In July 2019, 182,099 international tourists arrived in Buenos Aires by air (+8.8% YOY), led by Uruguay (+37%) YOY), USA and Canada (+22.6%), Brazil (+12.2%), Chile (+40.3%), and Rest of the Americas (+8.2%).
- International visitors made 1,7 million overnight stays, up +5,9% YOY.



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- Between January and July 2019, more than 1 million tourists (+16.7% YOY) arrived in Buenos Aires by air, 170,000 more visitors than in the same period in 2018. The increase was led by the outbound markets of Brazil (+31.6%), Chile (+21.5%) Uruguay (+20.5), and Europe (+12.7%).
- Total overnight stays from January through July reached 11.5 million, up +9.9% compared with the same period in 2018.






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II. NATIONAL TOURISM IN HOTELS

ARGENTINE TOURIST HOTEL STAYS. JULY 2018 – JULY 2019





- In July 2019, 250,307 Argentine tourists stayed in hotels in Buenos Aires (+1.5% YOY), making 577,800 overnight stays (+1.6%).
- The hotel occupancy rate was 62.3%, up +1.8 percentage points against the same period in 2018.
- -The accumulated occupancy rate (January to July) was 56.8% (-0.5 p.p. compared with 2018).
